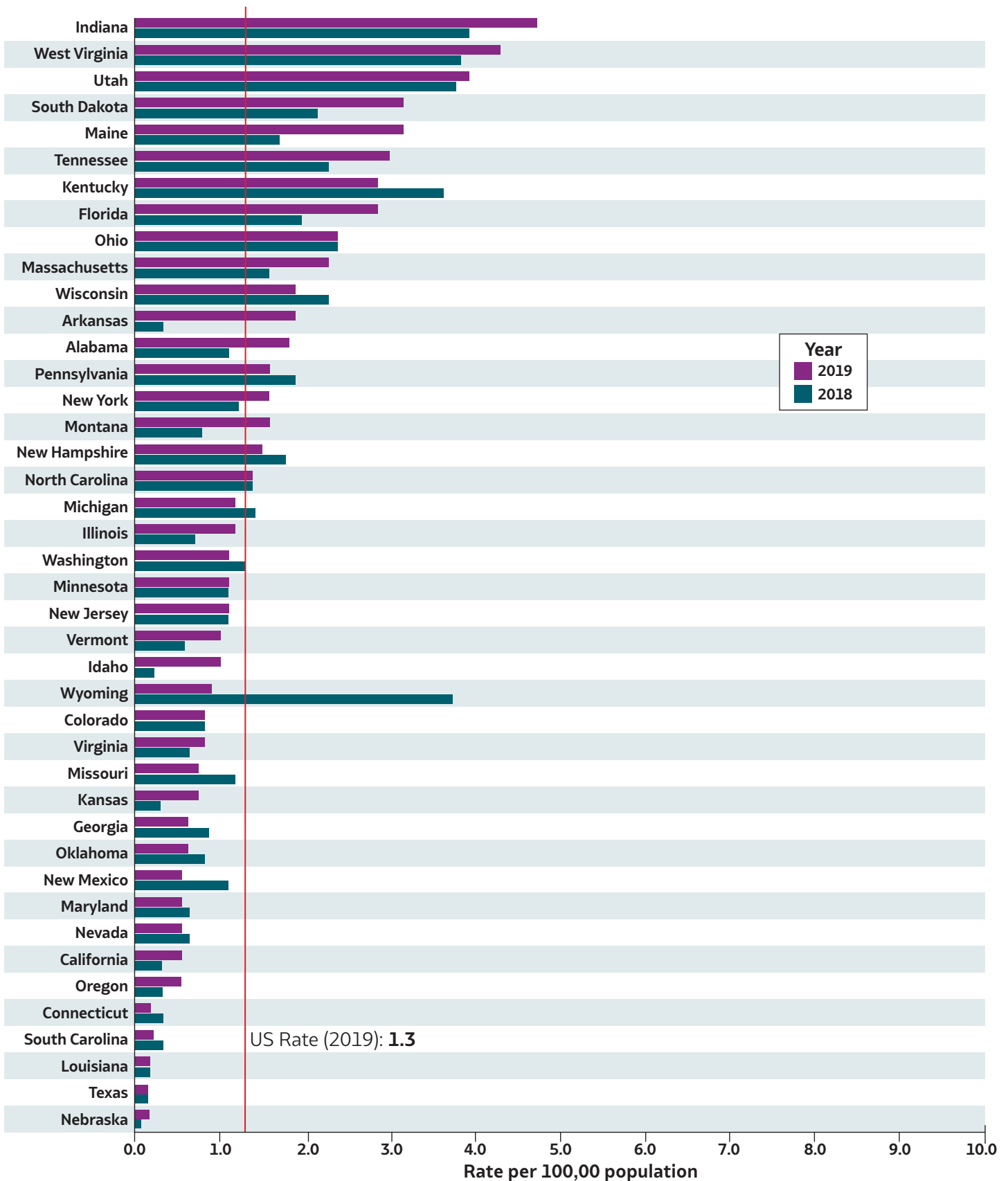


**Figure 3.2. Rates\* of reported acute hepatitis C<sup>+</sup> virus infections, by state — United States, 2018–2019**
