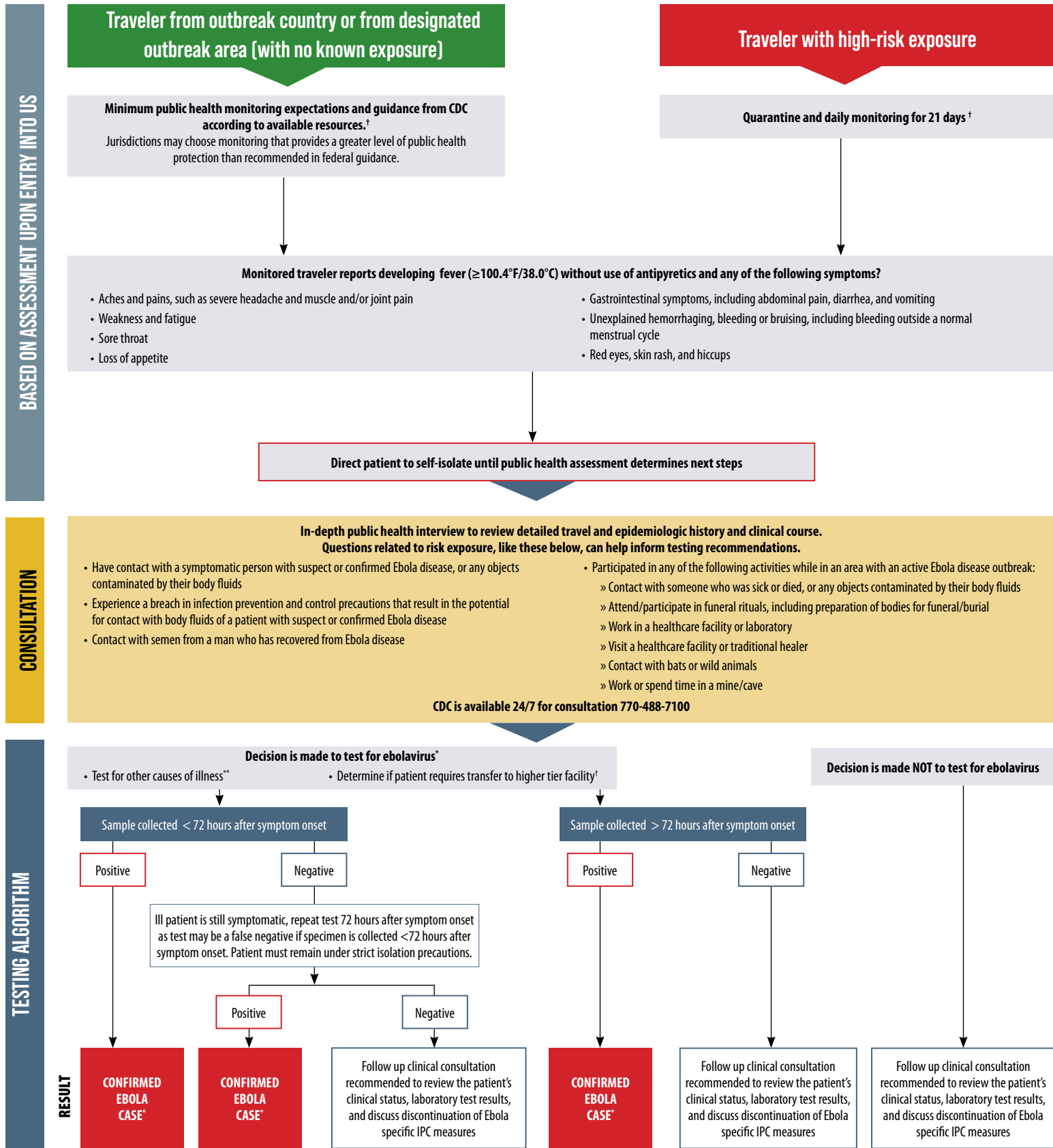


Guide for State, Tribal, Local, or Territorial Public Health Departments Monitoring a Returned Traveler for Ebola Disease
