Notice of Availability of Tourette Syndrome Pre-Research Data Center File

Due to small sample size posing an increased disclosure risk, data from the Tourette syndrome module will not be released as a public use microdata file. However, these data can be made available through the NCHS <u>Research</u> <u>Data Center</u> (RDC). In order to help users determine the feasibility of a proposed analysis within the RDC, researchers may access a "pre-RDC" file for preliminary analysis. The pre-RDC file has been perturbed and stripped of all potentially identifying variables.

Users interested in accessing the pre-RDC file must first complete and sign the <u>User's Agreement</u>, which describes the specific protections in place that meet the NCHS confidentiality standards for data users. Each data user who will have direct access to the pre-RDC file must sign the agreement. If emailing the signed user agreements, they must be completely legible, good-quality scans in either PDF or JPG format.
